A message from our Chairman Paul Sparks:

We are fortunate to be living in a very pleasant part of Uckfield and the Residents' Association does its best to enhance our amenities and daily enjoyment with such things as planters, benches, newly planted cherry trees and provides several valuable services for our residents with many of these described in this newsletter.

Being able to deliver these services depends largely on the annual membership subscriptions which, after ten years, continues to be just a modest £5 per household.

During this cost-of-living crisis, one of the most valuable membership benefits is the Shoppers Discount Scheme providing members with incredible discounts at a selection of local shops and businesses – more information about this can be found on page 2 and on our website.

I look forward to meeting many of you at one of our events in 2024.

So, what exactly does the Residents' Association do?

We thought it might be useful to tell you about just some of the things that the Association's Committee and volunteers have achieved in the past year:

Funding - obtained grants totalling over £5000 to support the services we provide.

Community events - organised the annual Big Picnic Lunch on the Rugby Club field with lots of excellent entertainment for every age group to enjoy and all provided for free.

Remembrance - installed a new wooden bench commemorating the late Queen's reign and laid a wreath at the War Memorial as part of the Remembrance Day parade and church service.

Streatfeild House - worked closely with Wealden District Council at the design stage for the redevelopment of the site. We continue to liaise with Wealden following the failure of the original construction company.

The new development will be named *Coronation Place* as suggested by Paul, our Chairman. **Roads** - gained the support of the County Councillor Claire Dowling when dealing with ESCC Highways over the poor state of Downsview Crescent and Southview Drive. As you will know Downsview Crescent has now been resurfaced and Southview Drive is due to follow.

Planning – we commented and where appropriate objected to planning applications and other proposals that affected our community such as the Downlands Farm application.

Warm Welcome project - following the success of the 'Warm Space' initiative, further funding was obtained and with the support of our volunteers the project continues as the 'The Warm Welcome', It is now grant funded until at least November 2024. The Warm Welcome is open to anyone living in Uckfield – every Tuesday in the Luxford Centre from 11am to 2pm.

New neighbours - new residents moving on to Manor Park and Hempstead Fields have a welcome pack delivered to them. If you have new neighbours, then please let us know.

Linden Court - the Surgery Car Service and Good Neighbour Scheme have been extended to include Linden Court. This joins the other retirement complexes of Grants Hill Court, Manor House Court and Shaftesbury Court which benefit from our services, even though they are all located outside of our patch.

Education – we continue to engage with the schools on Manor Park and will soon be meeting the new College Principal to discuss how the College might become more involved in our work.
