#### The future of Streatfeild House



As previously reported in the local media Wealden District Council has decided to go ahead with a project to provide 55 new upgraded homes on the site of Streatfeild House.

We understand that an application has been made to the government to allow the council to porrow money to rung the scheme and that various options are being considered.

Many of the residents of Streatfeild House have begun moving into the excellent accommodation provided at Grants Hill Court. Those who have chosen to do this being eligible for a home loss payment.

Streatfeild House is an important part of our community and the Association will continue to keep in touch with Wealden as the project progresses. We have already floated the idea of a sensory garden being incorporated into the design. Whilst no promises have been made there was a positive response to the idea.

In the meantime, we are looking at offering to extend the Surgery Car Service and the Good Neighbour Scheme to all the residents of Grants Hill Court.

## Uckfield College rebuild – the Project Manager answers the 20 questions put to him at the AGM

**Is the project on schedule?** - Yes, the north block should be completed late June 2020.

Assuming we have a good summer and with the students absent will this speed things up? - Yes, it will allow more deliveries (as agreed with the planners)

Pleased to see that double yellow lines have not appeared – Yes, we are only using traffic cones when necessary – as agreed with Paul Sparks. Once all the long lengths of steel have been delivered the parking restrictions will not be necessary.

Is the stone wall on the boundary going to be retained? - Yes, it is.

Parts of the site are prone to flooding, has this been recognised? - Yes, additional drainage has been incorporated into the scheme.

Downsview Crescent has never looked so clean, may be the street sweeper is being used too frequently, could it be extended to other roads on the planning conditions.

The road surface in Downsview Crescent is deteriorating, who will make this good? - The road was surveyed before the work started and it will be reinstated to the project.

It was noted that ESCC Highways had been repairing potholes in the last day or two. Any repairs by the contractor are subject to the permission of ESCC – takes 8-10 weeks.

What are the current parking arrangements for those working at the site? - They are instructed to park in the Luxford Field car park behind Tesco. Not all sub-contractors are abiding by this, if they persist they will lose their contract.

Could a Park and Ride system be introduced for them? – No sorry, sub-contractors start and leave at different times

Could they use the playground during the summer break? - Kevin will speak to the College about this idea

Please tell us about the portacabins on the site - There are extensive welfare facilities for the workmen, all designed to be eco-friendly

The Considerate Constructors Scheme includes a requirement to support the community, how is this being addressed? - Through engaging with the College and Manor Primary – visits by students etc.

Currently the site attracts a score of 4.5 stars in the Considerate Constructors Scheme, what would need to be done to get the full 5 stars? - Only very large projects can achieve 5 starts where they can afford to devote extensive funding to community projects.

Noticed that the fencing in the tree protection area has been moved back, why is this? - One tree is dead and necessary for operational reasons – permission has been obtained from the planners.

What has been the greatest frustration? - Co-ordinating deliveries from suppliers as far away as Sheffield and Northern Ireland.

**Will the shrubs along the fence bordering Downsview Crescent be replaced?** - Yes, new trees and shrubs will be planted in accordance with the planning requirements

How are you intending to engage with local residents, for example are you planning to take groups of residents around the site? - For health and safety reasons it is difficult to show people around a working site but happy to accept visitors (by prior arrangement).

Will the new college be able to take more students? – No, but this was a Education Au, decision

**Will a new pedestrian crossing is included in the scheme?** – the Association understands that it is not part of the scheme.
