Back to Work! - this article contributed by Sue Edwards

If you're a new Mum or Dad wanting to return to work, it is a good idea to do your homework before you go on the job hunt. You may not have applied for a job for some time, so let me give you some pointers.



Be prepared!

Decide what sort of job you want to do. If you're not sure, search for some skills match tests online. Ask yourself what you're good at and enjoy doing.

- **Don't use an old CV** that hasn't been updated for years, or knock up something that 'will do' for the time being. Your CV needs to impress right from the start to give yours a fighting chance!
- Free online resources are great, but you need to use the right wording and format, which may not be as easy as you think. Asking for <u>professional help</u> will save you a lot of time, hassle, and will greatly improve your chances of getting interviews.
- Once you've got a great CV get pro-active, especially online. Bear in mind that 90% of jobs are never advertised, so get on to social media and advertise yourself.
- Upload your new CV to job boards and set up text alerts so that new jobs come to you as soon as available.
- Get a presence online.
- Don't just apply for any job you find because you know you can do it.
- Tailor your initial CV to each job, leaving out all irrelevant information.

When you're ready to apply for jobs look at the requirements ie: skills and experience, and ensure that you are a good match. If you don't already have a good <u>Linkedin profile</u> get one, or ask your local CV Writer to create one for you and show you how to use it. It's THE main source of candidate search for most recruitment agencies and recruiting companies. Some only use Linkedin, so if you don't have a good profile you're missing out!
