Surgery Car Service up and running

A Surgery Car Service is now helping residents of Manor Park and Hempstead Fields get to their doctors' appointments at the new Meads Medical Centre and the Bird In Eye Surgery.

This new door to door service, which is operated by volunteers from the Manor Park and Hempstead Fields Residents' Association, is open to any resident living on Manor Park, Hempstead Fields or in Shaftesbury Court, London Road. It is intended to help patients that have transport difficulties get across the town to attend the new Meads Medical Centre in Bell Farm Road or the Bird In Eye Surgery at the hospital.

Manned entirely by volunteers and with a fixed charge of just £3.50 for each return trip it is hoped that this new service will meet the needs of those who do not own their own car or are unable to drive themselves.

The service operates Monday to Friday 9.30am to 4.30pm with advance bookings only.
